**Nationally known author,
nonprofit expert comes to Indy**

INDIANAPOLIS – October 12, 2007. Local nonprofit boards and executives will get a chance to learn how to think differently about leadership in order to become more effective. Nationally noted author and nonprofit consultant, William P. Ryan will provide tools and insights from his research to help nonprofit organizations be more effective.

The Nov. 8 workshop at the Indiana Historical Society is being co-sponsored by Lacy Leadership Association (LLA) and Leadership Ventures. The day will begin at 8 a.m. with a keynote address, which is open to the public.

In his book, *Governance as Leadership: Reframing the Work of Nonprofit Boards*, Ryan says leaders need to think differently about governance. Unlike board-in-a-box models that prescribe rigid operating instructions, the governance-as-leadership framework offers several practice principles that leaders can utilize to become more effective.
